A GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE ON
INCLUSIVE EDUCATION
WITH
DR. GORDON PORTER

Dr. Gordon Porter is the Director, Inclusive Education Canada, an Initiative of the Canadian Association for Community Living. He is also the Chair of the New Brunswick Human Rights Commission. He was Director of Student Services for the schools in the Woodstock area, after serving as a teacher and principal in several New Brunswick schools. A retired professor at the University of Maine at Presque Isle, he has also taught at McGill University, the University of Prince Edward Island and the University of Calgary. Dr. Porter studied at the University of New Brunswick, the University of Maine and Syracuse University in New York.

Dr. Porter is an internationally known expert on inclusive education who has consulted, lectured and conducted training in numerous countries around the world—most recently in Portugal, Peru, Columbia, Austria and Panama.

Dr. Porter will share some of his experiences with inclusive education from around the world, and help to put Manitoba's experiences into both a Canadian and global perspective.
